RYA Dinghy Instructor (inc assessment) (16+)

6 day course includes both training and assessment.
Pre reqs: RYA Pre-Assessment, 8 hour first aid, RYA Level 2

RYA Start Windsurfing Instructor (inc assessment) (16+)

Five-day course for new instructors includes both training and
assessment.

Pre reqs: RYA Intermediate Windsurfing Certificate inc beach start
and non-planing carve gybe clinics; 8 hour first aid, RYA Level 2
Powerboat



Archery (17+)

GNAS Archery Leader Award

Four day training and assessment course for those wishing to lead archery sessions and who want to introduce a programme for beginners

Pre reqs: None



Paddlesport

BCU Foundation Safety & Rescue Training (16+)

This is a pre-requisite for Level 1 Coach Course.

Pre reqs: BCU Two Star or skills to that standard in both canoe & kayak

BCU Level 1 Certificate in Coaching Paddlesport (16+)

4 Day course includes training and assessment.

Pre reqs: BCU 2 Star, Foundation Safety and Rescue Training, BCU coach registration

BCU Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Paddlesport - Training (17+)

4 Day training course.

Pre reqs: Level 1 Coach, 3 Star Award, BCU coach registration.

BCU Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Paddlesport - Assessment (18+)

1 day assessment .

Pre Reqs: Level 2 Training, 1 day first aid, CRB check, 2 x 3 Star Awards

Climbing

For those wishing to supervise climbing on artificial walls/towers within the Eastern Region only.

The course is recognised by Eastern Region Local Education Authorities.

Three stages: **Training - Further experience - Assessment.**

LEA Climbing Wall Supervisor Training (16+)

Initial training

Pre reqs; Basic climbing and belaying experience

LEA Climbing Wall Supervisor Assessment (18+)

Half day assessment

Pre reqs: Climbing wall supervisor training

LEA Climbing Wall Supervisor Revalidation

Half day revalidation after 3 years for those who have been previously assessed.

Mountain Biking

The Mountain Bike Instructor Award Scheme (MIAS) provides training and assessment for those wishing to lead cyclists in both on and off road environments.

Three stages: **Training - Further Experience - Assessment.**

MIAS Grade 1 & 2 Training

2 day training course.

Pre reqs: Basic off road cycling skills and experience

MIAS Grade 1 Assessment

1 day assessment for those who wish to lead groups in low level terrain.

Pre reqs: MIAS training & consolidation. First aid award.
